TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. You need a valid ticket that must be produced to gain entrance to the festival
 - a. Over 18 years of age, adult ticket
 - b. Under 18 year of age, child ticket
 - c. Under 1 year of age, infant ticket (these are free but they need a ticket)
2. All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 18
 - a. if the ticket holder is under 18 and not accompanied by an adult over the age of 18 then they will be refused entry - no refund will be given
3. The festival organisers ask that there are no more than 3 children per 1 adult
4. The festival security staff have the right to refuse entry if they feel the person is a risk to fellow festival attendees
5. Please don't be offended if the festival security ask to look in your bag – to ensure everyone's safety they may have to conduct searches
6. The festival security have the right to remove any attendee that is at risk of or causing a disturbance, there will be no refund of their ticket
7. No alcohol is to be brought into the festival
8. No smoking on school property
9. No dogs can be brought on to school property, except for assistance dogs
10. Parents/Guardians are responsible for their children at all times
11. If you look under 25 years of age please don't be offended when we ask you for ID, Waltonfest operate the "Challenge 25" policy

 - a. PayPal bookings incur a extra 20p per ticket charge, this will be also be deducted prior to refund
